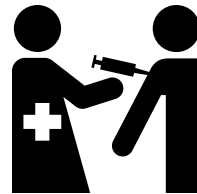

MCGILL HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP BURSARY PROGRAM

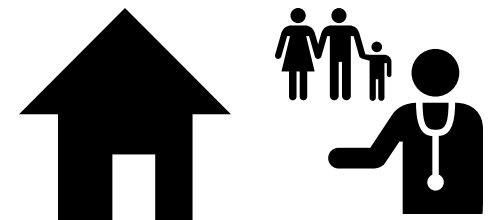
