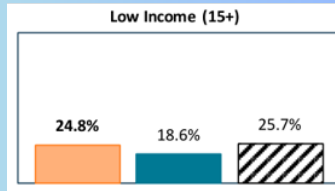
The number of English-speakers in the region of the Montérégie-Centre is 62,745 and represent 15% of the total population.



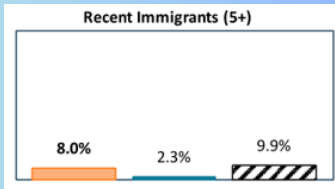
FACTORS PREVENTING ACCESS TO EMPLOYMENT *Statistics Canada Census 2021



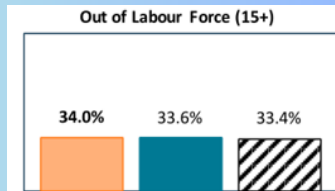
ESQ have lower income than Francophones
